

Census is important for local funding

The 2010 Census determines the distribution of more than \$300 billion annually of government funding for critical community services. Census questionnaires will be mailed to households via the U.S. Mail in March 2010.

By law, the Census Bureau cannot share any individual's census questionnaire responses with anyone, including other federal agencies and law enforcement entities.

Key dates to remember:

February-March 2010 - Census questionnaires mailed to households.

April 1, 2010 - Census Day

May-July 2010 - Census takers visit households that did not return questionnaire by mail.

December 2010 - Census delivers population counts to the president for apportionment.

March 2011 - Census Bureau completes delivery of redistricting data to states.
